

A proposed Settlement has been reached in a class action lawsuit known as
In re: Goodman Campbell Brain and Spine Data Incident Litigation,
Case No. 49D01-2207-PL-024807 (“Lawsuit”),
filed in the Commercial Court of Marion County, Indiana.

What is this about? This Lawsuit arises out of unauthorized access to Goodman Campbell Brain and Spine’s (“GCBS”) systems and certain files containing sensitive and/or personal information about GCBS’s patients and employees, which occurred between May 17, 2022, and May 20, 2022 (“Data Incident”).

Who is a Settlement Class Member? (i) All persons residing in Indiana who received written notification that their Social Security Number was potentially accessed, viewed, and/or obtained as a result of the Data Incident which occurred between May 17, 2022, and May 20, 2022, and (ii) Plaintiffs who filed suit against GCBS regarding the Data Incident before December 15, 2023.

What are the benefits? The Settlement provides for Settlement Class Members to file a claim for the following benefits: **Documented Out-of-pocket Expense Reimbursement:** Up to \$375 per Settlement Class Member; **Lost Time Reimbursement:** Reimbursement for up to four (4) hours of lost time spent dealing with the Data Incident (\$20 per hour) (subject to the \$375 cap when combined with Expense Reimbursement); **Documented Extraordinary Loss Reimbursement:** Up to \$5,000 per Settlement Class Member; **Credit Monitoring:** Two years of credit monitoring; **Information Security Improvements:** GCBS will also provide various security enhancements. You must file a claim by July 29, 2024 by mail or online at www.GCBSDataIncidentSettlement.com to receive benefits from the Settlement. Claim forms are available at www.GCBSDataIncidentSettlement.com. Your unique Login and Password on this Notice will be required to access the online and paper claim forms.

What are my other rights?

- **Do Nothing:** If you do nothing, you remain in the Settlement. You give up your rights to sue but you will not get any money; you must submit a claim to get any money.
- **Exclude yourself:** You can get out of the Settlement and keep your right to sue about the claims in this Lawsuit, but you will not get any money. You must exclude yourself by June 28, 2024.
- **Object:** You can stay in the Settlement but tell the Court why you think the Settlement should not be approved. Objections must be submitted by June 28, 2024. Detailed instructions on how to file a claim, get additional credit monitoring, exclude yourself, or object are on the Settlement Website below. The Court will hold the Final Fairness Hearing on August 19, 2024 at 9:30 a.m. to consider whether the proposed Settlement is fair, reasonable, and adequate, to consider Attorneys’ Fees, Costs, and Expenses in the total amount of \$610,000 and request a Class Representative service award of \$1,000 each, and to consider whether and if the Settlement should be approved.
